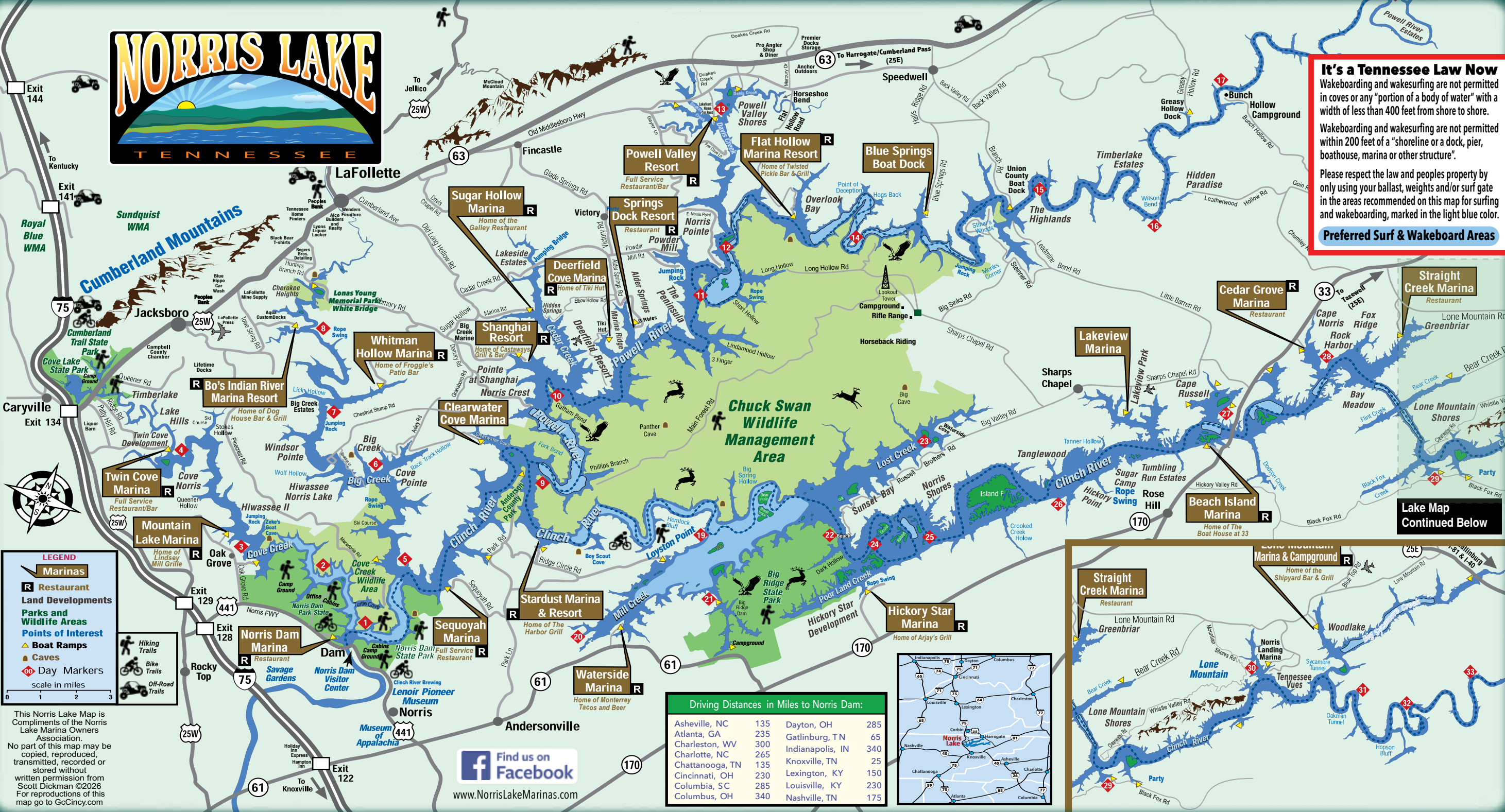

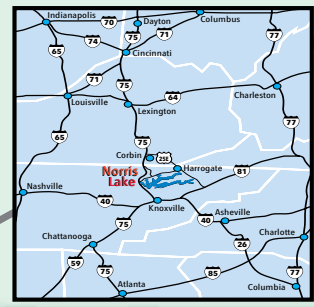

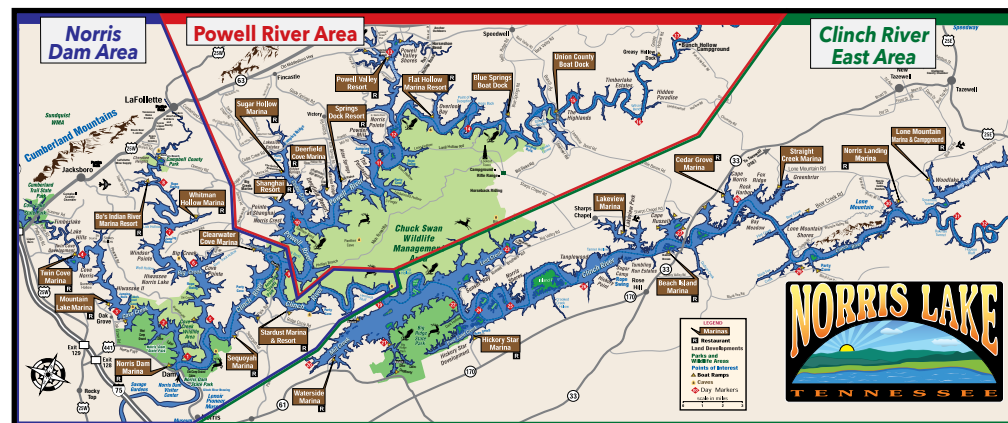

Let's Go Boating on Norris Lake

Nestled in the foothills of the Cumberland Mountains, just 20 miles north of Knoxville, lies Norris Lake. Renowned for its deep, clean waters, the lake is fed by over 3,000 miles of fresh water from mountain creeks, streams, and rivers. Unlike other lakes, Norris Lake is not fed by a major dam, ensuring its water remains cleaner and clearer. As spring temperatures warm the lake, the water maintains a pleasant temperature until late fall.

Norris Lake is the most popular TVA tributary lake for recreation. At its normal summer pool of 1020 feet above sea level, the lake spans over 34,200 acres of surface water. The water level fluctuates 20-30 feet annually, with changes exceeding 45 feet during droughts or floods some years. Fresh water replenishes the lake every nine months, primarily from mountain rainfall.

Stretching 56 miles along the Powell River and 72 miles along the Clinch River, Norris Lake also features miles of multiple creeks. Its 809 miles of shoreline offer many activities like golfing, hiking, horseback riding, rock climbing, cliff jumping, caving, and camping. With over 50 more miles of island shoreline, visitors can enjoy many picnic areas, as well as caves, cliffs and beaches.

Norris Lake boasts secluded coves, three state parks, county parks, two wildlife management areas, and 59 public access sites. Located in Anderson, Campbell, Claiborne, Grainger, and Union counties in Tennessee, the lake is a hot spot for fishing tournaments year-round. With over 56 fish species, including striper, walleye, and crappie, anglers can fish from shore, they can bring their own boat, rent one, or hire a guide service to take them out.



Marinas around Norris Lake offer a variety of great accommodations, including lakefront and lakeview houses, condos, hotels, houseboats, and floating cabins for rent or purchase.

Additional amenities include boat and slip rentals, waterfront restaurants, campgrounds, lake maps, groceries, snacks, apparel, and boating supplies. Many marinas host events like karaoke, live bands, kids' activities, and themed parties, as well as party rooms for reunions, weddings and business functions.

Don't miss exciting events like the Crownline and Mastercraft boat gatherings, the Norris Lake Beach Party, the Rocky Top Power Run, weekend boat tie-ups, holiday parties, and fireworks displays at Cedar Grove, Deerfield Resort, Flat Hollow, Indian River, Sequoyah, Shanghai, Sugar Hollow, Lone Mountain and Whitman Hollow.



Norris Lake Dam

Norris Dam was built to promote economic development and control flooding in the Tennessee Valley.

As the first project of the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA), construction began on October 1, 1933, and was completed in March 1936, with the reservoir filled by 1937. Over 2,750 workers poured more than one million square yards of concrete, and the project cost \$36 million, including land acquisition (that's \$850 million in today's dollars). The dam's construction displaced nearly 2,900 families and relocated over 5,000 grave sites.

Named after U.S. Senator George W. Norris, who authored the legislation creating the TVA, the dam is a straight concrete gravity-type structure measuring 1,860 feet long, 265 feet high, and 208 feet thick at the base. At summer pool, it holds back over 830 billion gallons of water. Equipped with two 50,000-kilowatt hydroelectric turbines, the dam generates an average daily capacity of 126 megawatts in summer. Its spill waters flow through nine dams along the Tennessee River, eventually reaching Kentucky Lake and the Ohio River.

Surrounding Norris Dam is Norris Dam State Park, offering two campgrounds, cabin rentals, rent-able indoor and outdoor facilities, hiking and biking trails, horseback riding trails, a museum, playgrounds, picnic areas, gift shops, and seasonal recreational programs. Norris Dam Area

Clinch River West, Big Creek and Cove Creek

The Norris Dam Area includes the Clinch River from Norris Lake Dam to day marker 19 at Loyston Point, as well as Cove Creek and Big Creek. **Norris Dam Marina** is located where the Clinch River and Cove Creek meet at the dam (day marker 1). Day markers on Norris Lake help identify points, areas, and assist with navigation. These markers, numbered 1 to 33, are placed 1-5 miles apart on day boards located at points, islands, marinas, and shores. Most Norris Lake maps feature these markers to help navigation and to locate creeks, points, and marinas.

Cove Creek begins at Cove Lake State Park in Caryville where Cove Lake flows into Norris Lake. Along Cove Creek, you'll find **Twin Cove Resort and Marina** at day marker 4 and **Mountain Lake Marina and Campground** at day marker 3. Both Marinas offer restaurants and live entertainment. The Norris Dam State Park, Anderson County Park (campground, boat ramp, and beach), Lonas Young Memorial Park (campground, boat

ramp, beach, and sports fields), and Cove Creek Wildlife Area are located in the Norris Dam Area. Big Creek flows from downtown LaFollette, past Lonas Young Memorial Park under Demory Road, and into the Clinch River close to **Sequoyah Marina**, known for their Friday night wings special. **Bo's**

Indian River Marina (day marker 8) and **Whitman Hollow Marina** (near day marker 7) are located along Big Creek, both offering dining, snacks, drinks, and live entertainment.

Farther up the Clinch River, Anderson County Park and **Clear Cove Marina** are near the merging point of the Clinch and Powell Rivers at day marker 9. **Stardust**

Marina, known for its Friday Night Seafood Boil and delicious cheeseburgers, is located just beyond day marker 9.

The Clinch River winds past Loyston Point at day marker 19, where the lake opens to its widest section, marking the beginning of Clinch River East.

Bike, hike, and explore the trail-network around Norris Lake! With hundreds of miles of routes spanning gentle hikes, challenging mountain-bike terrain, and off-road adventures, there's plenty of fun beyond the water. Bring your bike or OHV — or just lace up your hiking boots — and head into the forests and ridges of our city, county, state and national lands.

Hike to the cascading Little Egypt Waterfalls or reach the stunning tri-state vista above Cumberland Gap National Historical Park. For off-road excitement, ride the dramatic terrain at Royal Blue Wildlife Management Area or Windrock Park

in the Cumberland Mountains — and don't miss the rugged off-road routes in Sundquist Wildlife Management Area. You can rent a 4-wheeler and pick up a map with directions and rules. Events and group rides happen throughout the year.

For cyclists, the Norris Area Mountain Bike Trails offer thrilling rides and dramatic views of the lake. Kick your lake-season off early by joining the annual Poker Run in April — proceeds go toward trail improvements.

Powell River Area

Powell River, Cedar Creek & Davis Creek

The Powell River, one of the two rivers that form Norris Lake, flows into the Clinch River about 10 miles northeast of Norris Dam, near Anderson County Park at day marker 9. The river stretches 56 miles northeast, passing day marker 18 and winding under Highway 25E between Harrogate, TN, and Tazewell, TN. Along its path, the Powell River offers breathtaking views of the Cumberland Mountains to the northwest and the Chuck Swan Wildlife Management Area to the south and east. Resorts and Marinas along the Powell River include:

- **Shanghai Resort:** Located across the lake from day marker 10, enjoy some great food and drinks at the restaurant and let the kids enjoy the splash pad.
- **Deerfield Resort:** Nestled along the shores of Cedar Creek and the Powell River, just past day marker 10, is one of the largest lakeside communities.
- **Deerfield Cove Marina, Tiki Hut, and Springs Dock Resort** are all found between day markers 10 & 11. These lively destinations are ideal for dining.

Fishing on Norris Lake

Known for Stripers, Rockfish, Walleye, Catfish, Largemouth, Smallmouth, Bluegill, Crappie and Black Crappie

Norris Lake, with its deep, crystal-clear waters, offers the ideal habitat for a variety of fish species, making it a top destination for anglers nationwide. Whether you're a seasoned tournament competitor or a family looking for a fun day on the water, Norris Lake is the perfect spot to cast your line and reel in a great catch.

Fishing License Information

To fish or assist someone in fishing at Norris Lake, a Tennessee fishing license is required. This includes catching fish or crayfish by any method. Non-residents can choose from annual, 10-day, or 3-day licenses, with options for all fish or no trout. Children under 13 are exempt from needing a license.

Annual fishing licenses go on sale starting February 18, just in time for prime fishing season, and remain valid until the last day of February the following year. Licenses can be purchased online, by mail, or at various locations such as county court clerks' offices, sporting goods stores, hardware stores, and marinas. For more details or to purchase a license, visit goutdoor.tennessee.com.

Stay informed about local fishing tournaments, area guides, and helpful tips by checking with marinas, browsing websites, or keeping an eye on local newspapers.

New Creel and Size Limits (as of 11-19-25)

Largemouth/Smallmouth Bass: 5 per day in combination. Only 1 smallmouth bass June 1 through Oct. 15.

Largemouth Bass: 14-inch minimum length limit.

Smallmouth Bass: June 1-Oct. 15: 1 per day, 18-inch minimum length limit.
Oct. 16-May 31: 5 per day, 15-inch minimum length limit.

Spotted/Alabama Bass: No creel, no length limit.

Crappie (all species): 10 per day in combination, 10-inch minimum length limit.

Catfish (all species): No creel limit for fish 34 inches and less in length; only 1 fish over 34 inches in length may be harvested per day.

Striped Bass: Apr. 1-Oct. 31: 2 per day, 15-inch minimum length limit.

Nov. 1-Mar. 31: 1 per day, 36-inch minimum length limit.

White Bass: 15 per day, no length limit.

Yellow Bass: No creel or length limit.

Walleye/Sauger: 5 per day in combination, 15-inch minimum length limit (upstream to Grissom Island on the Clinch River).

Paddlefish: 2 per day; season is open from April 24 through May 31. Culling is prohibited.

Rock Bass: 20 per day, no length limit.

Redear Sunfish: 20 per day, no length limit.

Muskellunge: 1 per day, 36-inch minimum length limit.

Bluegill/Warmouth and other sunfishes: 30 per day, No length limit.

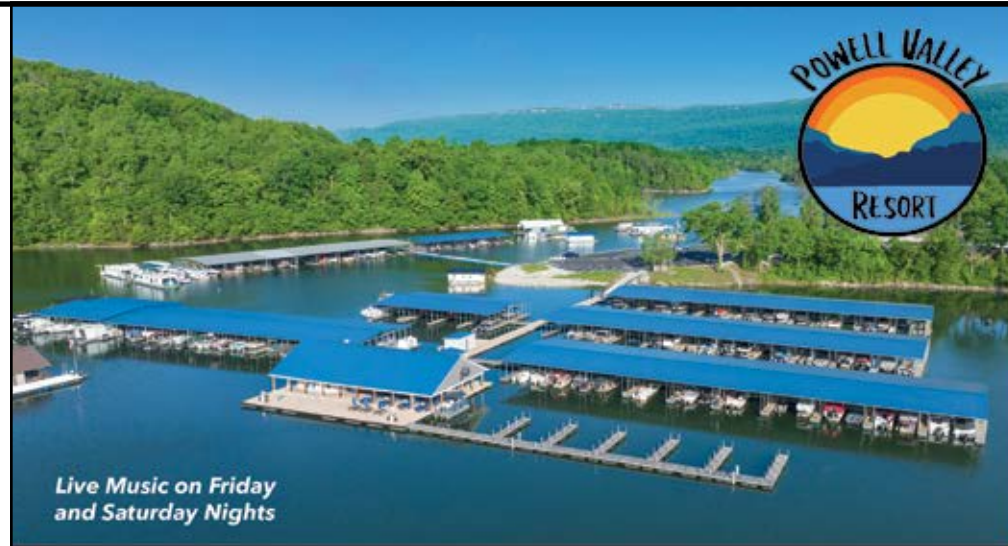

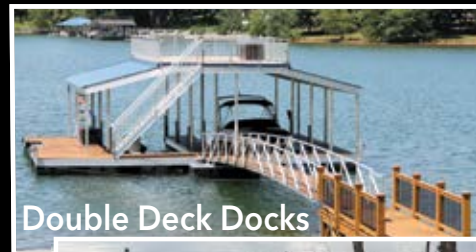

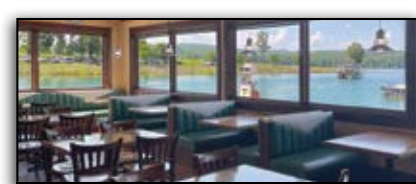

Clinch River East Area

Clinch River from Loyston Point to Rt 25E, Mill Creek, Lost Creek, Poor Land Creek and Big Sycamore Creek

The Clinch River East Area spans from Loyston Point to Route 25E, including Mill Creek, Lost Creek, Poor Land Creek, and Big Sycamore Creek. Starting just past Loyston Point at day marker 19, the lake opens up to its widest section.

On the expansive lake near Mill Creek, you'll find **Waterside Marina** to the southwest around day marker 20. Stop by on the weekend to enjoy delicious Mexican food.

Big Ridge State Park is nestled between day markers 21 and 22, surrounded by Norris Lake and featuring many secluded coves. Across from day marker 24, on the southern shore of the Clinch River, sits **Hickory Star Marina**, located just past the open lake and near several islands. Further along, near day marker 27 and the new 33 bridge, you'll find **Lakeview Marina** and **Beach Island Marina** and the **Boat House Restaurant and Bar**. Stop by either restaurant for some great food.



Beyond the 33 bridge, **Cedar Grove Marina** is located at day marker 28. Around the corner, you'll come across **Straight Creek Marina**, just before reaching the Lone Mountain Shores development. At day marker 30, **Norris Landing Marina** and Jimmy's Place Restaurant offer a great spot to relax and eat. A little further along, past Big Sycamore Creek and under the railroad bridge, you'll find **Lone Mountain Marina** and Campground with plenty of activities and theme nights.

Norris Lake continues to wind through scenic hills for over 15 miles, passing under a railroad bridge and offering undisturbed views. The Clinch River eventually flows under Route 25E, where the water becomes too shallow for navigation.

Boater's Etiquette on Norris Lake

Norris Lake offers 34,000 acres of water for everyone to enjoy, so let's all be respectful of others as they partake in their favorite activities. Whether you're fishing, wakeboarding, surfing, skiing, tubing, cruising, swimming or jet skiing, we can all share this beautiful lake by being considerate. Here are some common-sense guidelines to ensure everyone has a great time:

Main Channel Activities

Wake Surfing & Tubing: Follow the law—no surfing in front of docks or marinas, within 200 feet of the shoreline, or in areas less than 400 feet wide. Refer to state laws on Page 64 for more details. Notice the lake map has preferred areas for wakesurfing and wakeboarding.

Cove Activities

Smooth Water Activities: Activities like slalom skiing, trick skiing, bare footing, floating, swimming, fishing, kayaking, paddle boarding, and snorkeling are best suited for calm coves. Avoid creating unnecessary wakes in these areas to protect people and property. Please be considerate of no wake zones.

Anchoring in Coves: If someone is skiing in a cove, avoid anchoring in the middle. Instead, anchor at the front or back of the cove. If skiing bothers you, consider choosing another cove.

Ski Courses: Never tie to or anchor near a ski course.

Personal Watercraft (PWC) Guidelines

PWCs should never follow or jump waves behind boats towing tubers, skiers, wakeboarders, or surfers. Maintain at least 300 feet (the length of a football field) from anyone being towed.

Safety Tips

Never sit on the bow or stern of a moving boat or pontoon. This is dangerous and illegal but could also result in injury or a ticket. Captains are responsible for the safety and actions of their passengers.

Music and Noise

Keep music at a reasonable volume when sharing a cove with others. Loud music may not be appreciated, especially by families with children. Please be respectable and do not play any music with vulgar language around areas children may be.

When entering or leaving a marina, maintain low music volume and adhere to no-wake zones.

Cove Courtesy

If you see boats tied up side by side in a cove, treat it as a no-wake zone to prevent their boats from banging together. Slow down before entering and when leaving.

If staying overnight in a cove, leave your anchor light (white lights) on and clearly mark any ropes in the water.

If a cruiser or houseboat is already anchored overnight, consider choosing another unoccupied cove.

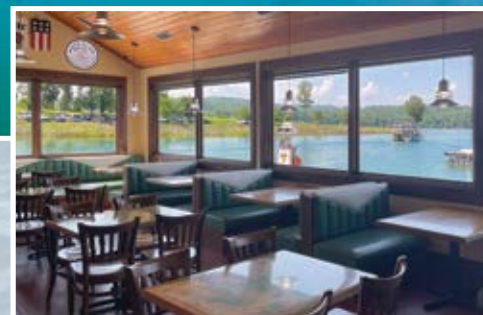

Boating Safety, Laws and Tips

As a boat owner and/or operator YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE for your safety, the safety of all your passengers and the safety of other boaters as well. Always be aware and alert of everything around you when driving a boat.

- TWRA (Tennessee Wildlife Resource Agency) and the US Coast Guard patrol and enforce boating laws on Norris Lake. Know and obey the laws of the state and the rules of the lake. For a complete handbook of Tennessee boating laws visit: <https://www.tn.gov/content/dam/tn/twra/documents/boating/TN-Boating-Handbook.pdf>
- For safety and to prevent collisions, every operator should follow the three basic rules of navigation.

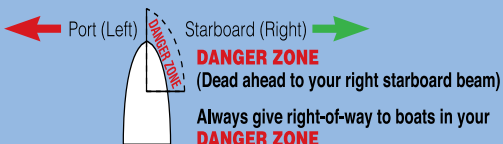
1. Practice good seamanship. 2. Keep a sharp lookout. 3. Maintain a safe speed and distance.

- **ALWAYS** provide everyone with an appropriate size PFD before leaving the dock and have them readily available.
- Children 12 and under must wear a Personal Flotation Device (PFD) while underway. (State Law) **Be sure all PFDs fit properly.**
- **ALWAYS** maintain a safe speed depending on your surroundings. When in doubt, SLOW DOWN OR STOP.
- Be aware of other boats and swimmers around you. Swimmers are hard to see so always look out for them.
- **ALWAYS** look in all directions before starting out, turning or changing course. Then look again.
- When approaching a boat, the boat dead ahead and on your right has the right away. Slow down and allow plenty of room OR change course and go behind the other boat (always a better option).
- Slow down before approaching docks, boats, swimmers, shore, bridges, busy areas or any object.
- **SLOW DOWN** close to marinas. **No Wake means Idle Speed, which is the SLOWEST you can go while maintaining control.** You are always responsible for damages from your wake. Please always be courteous to others in the marinas and other boats anchored or fishing where ever they are. Turn your music down when entering or leaving a marina. Your loud music may not be appreciated or appropriate.
- Distribute your load evenly and never overload your boat.
- **NEVER** follow directly behind other boats or PWCs. (Boats do not have brake lights.)
- PWCs cannot be operated between sunset and sunrise.
- As a boat driver, you are responsible for any passenger in your boat and can be fined for their actions, including those drinking. Tell your passengers not to move around the boat once the boat is moving above idle speed.
- **NEVER** allow your boat or PWC to be driven by an inexperienced operator without proper instructions.
- Anyone born after 1-1-89 who operates a boat or PWC without an adult aboard that was born on or before 1-1-89 must have taken and passed a Coast Guard approved boating education course (TWRA or NASBLA - National Association of State Boating Law Administrators) and have their certificate with them. Those less than 12 years old must have a supervisor on board who is at least 18 years old and able to take immediate control of the vessel. The supervisor, if born after 1-1-89, also must have a Boating Safety Education Certificate issued by TWRA or NASBLA. Children 12 years old or older operating alone must have a Boating Safety Education Certificate issued by TWRA or NASBLA with them.
- As a boat owner and driver you are responsible by law to make sure your lights on your boat are working properly and are on 1/2 hour before sunset until 1/2 hour after sunrise. Even if you don't expect to be out at night things happen so be prepared. Boating lights are for other boaters to see you. If your boat lights do not work, people may not see you. Don't put you and other passengers in your boat as well as other boaters at risk. According to the law docking lights should only be used within 50' of a dock.
- **DO NOT** drink alcohol and drive a boat at any time. Alcohol is a major contributor to boating accidents and fatalities. If your trip includes any drinking use a designated non-drinking driver. Be Safe! Be Smart! Have Fun!

The U. S. Coast Guard asks all boat owners and operators to help reduce fatalities, injuries, property damage and associated healthcare costs related to recreational boating accidents by taking personal responsibility for their own safety and the safety of their passengers. Essential steps include always wearing a life jacket; never boat under the influence; successfully complete a boating safety course; and get a vessel safety check annually from your local U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary or United States Power Squadrons.

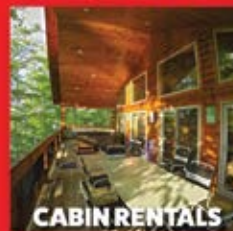

Tennessee New Surf/Wake Laws

A new Tennessee law concerning Wake Boats and Surf Boats went into effect on July 1, 2022 as follows:

1. Wakeboarding and wakesurfing is prohibited before sunrise or after sunset. This provision was already in place for jet-skiers, skiers, etc. The new law simply includes wakeboarders and wakesurfers in the prohibition.
2. Wakeboarding and wakesurfing are no longer permitted in coves or any "portion of a body of water" with a width of less than 400 feet.
3. Wakeboarding and wakesurfing are not permitted within 200 feet of a "shoreline or a dock, pier, boathouse, or other structure located completely or partly on the water". It's best and most considerate not to wakeboard or wakesurf around any houses, docks or marinas.
4. Wakeboarders and wakesurfers must wear a personal flotation device approved by the U.S. Coast Guard.

Pursuant to T.C.A. 69-9-219, violation of the new law is a Class C misdemeanor punishable by up to 30 days in jail and up to a \$50 fine and court costs.

Please Wake Responsibly

1. **Stay at least 200 feet away** from the shoreline, docks, boats, marinas, high traffic areas or other structures.
2. **Keep music at reasonable levels:** Since sound travels well over water, if its loud enough to hear at 80 feet back, it is likely loud enough for homeowners and boats in marinas to hear also.
3. **Minimize repetitive passes** on any one part of the shoreline, move on after a few passes.

Remember, you are responsible for your own wake, Please be considerate.

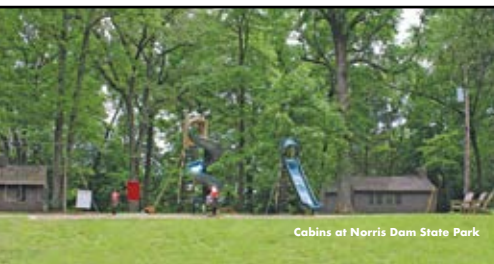

Please read about registration process, permits and rules.

Floating cabins must comply with the rules contained in TVA's Section 26a Regulations at <https://www.tva.com/26aregulations>

In accordance with §1304.101(c), all floating cabins shall comply with the rules and **make an application for a Section 26a permit by October 1, 2029**. TVA may, at its sole discretion, deny an initial application for a floating cabin submitted after this date. Unpermitted structures are subject to removal.

New floating cabins are prohibited. No modifications to a floating cabin or attached structures can be made without prior written approval from TVA.

Any deviations from the approved plans will require physical corrections to the structure(s) and/or a request to approve the violations through another Section 26a permit.

The registration process is to connect an owner to a structure in TVA's floating cabins inventory. Registration is not a Section 26a permit approval of the floating cabin.
