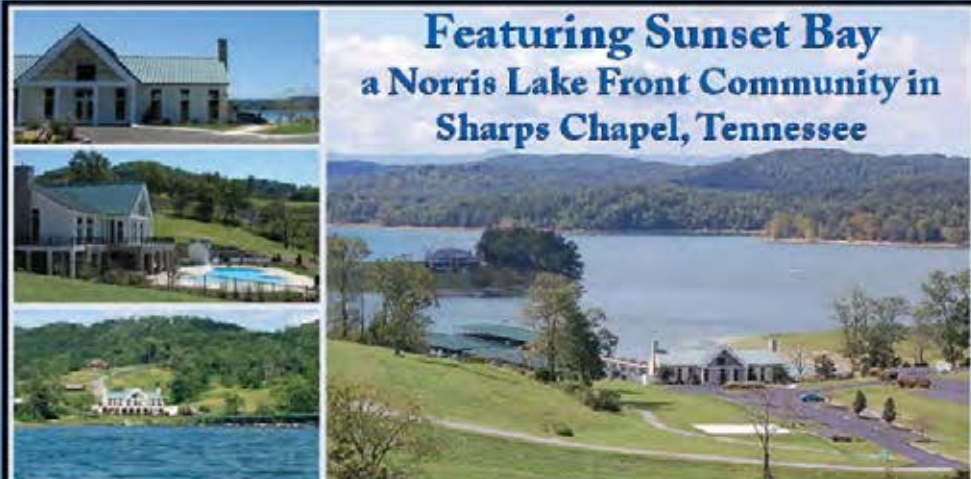

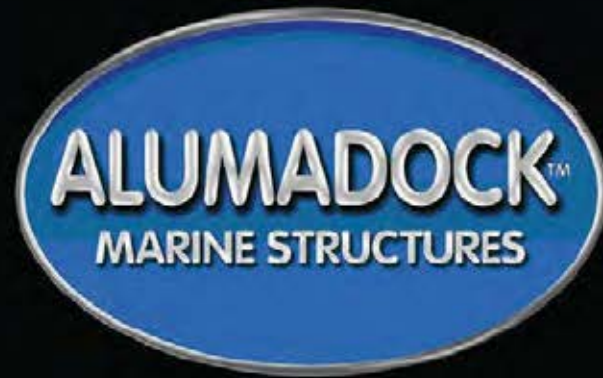

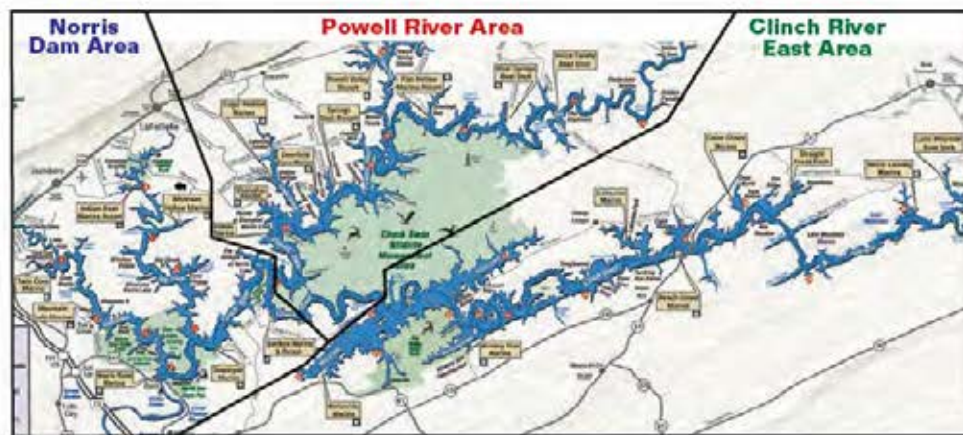

Where Memories Are Made



Nestled 20 miles north of Knoxville in the foothills of the Cumberland mountains lies Norris Lake. Well known for its deep clean waters, the lake consists of two major rivers and numerous creeks. The lake is fed by more than 3,000 miles of clean creeks, streams and rivers, mostly from the mountains. Since the lake is not fed by any major dam, the water is much cleaner than most other lakes. Once the sun begins to warm the water in spring, it tends to maintain a nice and steady warm temperature until fall.

Recreational use of Norris Lake exceeds that of any other TVA tributary lake. At the lake's normal summer pool of 1020 feet (above sea level), there are over 34,200 acres of surface water. Endless fun-filled activities await you and your family. Norris Lake is well known for its striper fishing along with over 56 species of fish, making it popular for fishing tournaments year-round.

Norris Lake extends 56 miles up the Powell River and 73 miles into the Clinch River. Along the 850 miles of shoreline, including islands, many fun activities can be enjoyed such as golfing, hiking, horseback riding, rock climbing, cliff jumping, caving and camping. The shoreline includes over 50 miles of island along with numerous picnic areas, caves, cliffs, and beaches. Norris Lake has many secluded coves, three state parks, two wildlife management areas and 59 public access sites. Anderson, Campbell, Claiborne, Grainger, and Union Counties are all home to Norris Lake.

Norris Lake marinas offer lakefront and lakeview houses, condos, hotels, houseboats and float houses for rent. They also offer boat and slip rentals, a great selection of food and entertainment at their restaurants, groceries, snacks and boating supplies to make your vacation complete.

Some marinas have karaoke, live bands, and theme parties along with party rooms available for reunions, weddings and business functions. Don't miss all the marinas' events like the marinas' firework shows, the Crownline, Mastercraft and Malibu boat gatherings, holiday parties and "Fire on the Water" fireworks at Sequoyah Marina on the Saturday before July 4th. Norris Lake Dam



Norris Dam was created to bring economic development to the region and control the rampant flooding that had long plagued the Tennessee Valley. The dam was the first project built by the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA). Construction was started in October 1933, completed March 1936 and filled by 1937. During construction, workers poured over one million square yards of concrete. Cost of construction including land acquisition, was close to 36 million. The dam project relocated almost 2,900 families and caused the removal and relocation of over 5,000 grave sites.

Norris Lake was named after George W. Norris, the author of the legislation that created the TVA. Norris was a U.S. senator from Nebraska that had proposed constructing a network of dams throughout the valley to help regulate its outflow into the lower Mississippi River. The TVA is a federally-owned corporation created by congressional charter in 1933 to provide navigation, flood control, electricity generation, fertilizer manufacturing, and economic development in the Tennessee Valley. TVA's service area covers most of Tennessee, portions of Alabama, Mississippi, and Kentucky, and small parts of Georgia, North Carolina, and Virginia.

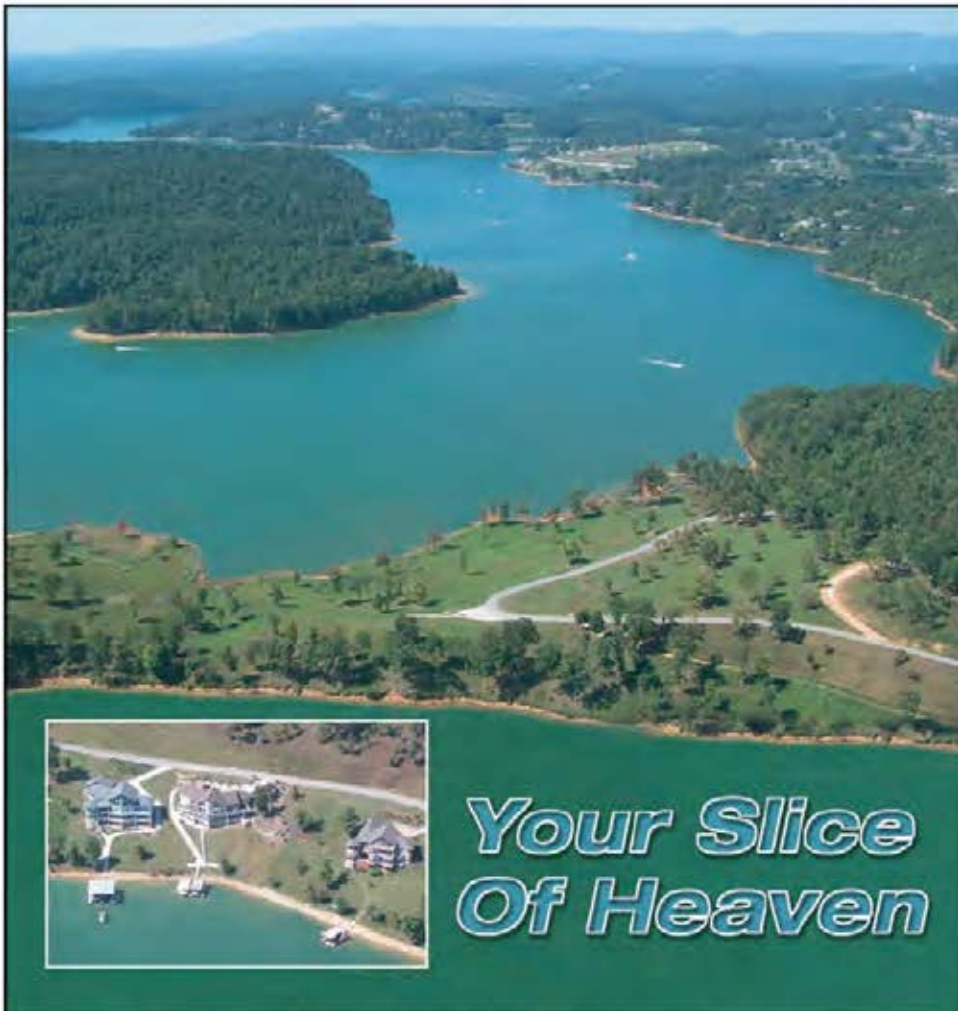
Norris Dam is a straight concrete gravity-type dam, 1860 feet long, 265 feet high, and 208 feet thick at the base.

The dam is equipped with two 50,000-kilowatt generators. Norris Dam provides flood control and recreation; generates hydroelectricity and helps improve navigation of the Tennessee River. The Norris Dam holds back around 830 billion gallons of water. The two turbine hydroelectric generators can produce up to 100,800 kilowatts of electric. The spill waters offer great trout fishing, and flow into the Tennessee River, through Alabama, Tennessee and Kentucky and eventually into the Ohio River.

Norris Dam State Park surrounds the dam with many facilities and offers hiking trails, playgrounds, swimming pools, tennis courts, a lodge, picnic areas, campground, cabin rentals and recreational programs. On the top east side of the dam there is a visitors center and on the west side an overlook with parking that provides a great vista for photos. A picnic area is at the base of the dam next to the spill waters, where you will find some of the best trout fishing around.

Clinch River West, Big Creek and Cove Creek

The Norris Dam Area encompasses the Clinch River from Norris Lake dam to day marker 19 at Loyston Point, along with Cove Creek and Big Creek. The Norris Dam Marina overlooks the dam waters where the Clinch River and Cove Creek meets at day marker 1.

Day markers are used on Norris Lake for identifying points and areas of the lake and to help in navigation. They are located 1-5 miles apart on signs called day boards on the shores of Norris Lake with numbers ranging from 1 to 33. They are on most maps to help locate different areas, creeks, points and marinas on the lake.

Cove Creek flows from Cove Lake State Park to the dam. Cove Lake drains into Norris Lake at the beginning of Cove Creek. Along Cove Creek there are two marinas, Twin Cove Marina at day marker 4 and Mountain Lake Marina at day marker 3. The Norris Dam State Park and the Cove Creek Wildlife area border Cove Creek where the creek meets the Clinch River. The Norris Dam State Park also runs along the shores of the Clinch River before you get to Sequoyah Marina, not far from where Big Creek joins the Clinch River at day marker 5.



Big Creek flows from outside of downtown LaFollette by the Campbell County Park and under the White Bridge to the Clinch River. Indian River Marina at day marker 8 and Whitman Hollow Marina, close to day marker 7, are both located on Big Creek.

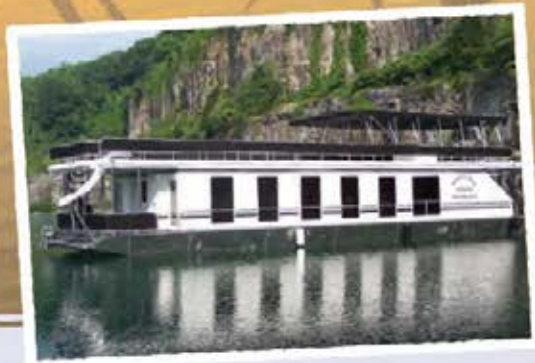
Farther up the Clinch River is the Anderson County Park located where the Clinch and Powell Rivers merge at day marker 9. This park has a swimming area, playground and campground all along the shores. Stardust Marina is just around the corner, up a little from day marker 9 on the Clinch River.

The Clinch River twists and winds its way past Loyston Point at day marker 19 where the lake opens up to the widest part. This is where the Clinch River East begins.

Fishing on Norris Lake

The deep clear waters of Norris Lake create a perfect habitat for rockfish, walleye, catfish largemouth, smallmouth, bluegill and crappie. Also famous for its trophy-size stripers, walleye and catches of black crappie, Norris Lake has become a favorite destination and tournament venue for anglers across the country.

License Information

A Tennessee fishing license is required if you take fish or attempt to take fish (including crayfish) by any method or if you assist someone else to do so. Non-residents have a choice of annual, 10-day or 3-day fishing license, for either all fish or no trout. If you are under 13, you do not need a license.

Annual fishing licenses go on sale February 18, the start of prime fishing and are valid until the last day of February the following year. Licenses are available by phone, on the web, by mail or from the county court clerks, some sporting goods stores, hardware stores and marinas. To purchase a license or for more information, call 888-814-8972 or visit www.tnwildlife.org. If a fishing license is purchased by phone, you will be given an authorization number that will allow you to fish immediately. Call the marinas, search web sites or watch local papers for information on local fishing tournaments, area guides and other tips.

Creel and Size Limits (as of 2013)

Largemouth/Smallmouth Bass:
5 per day in combination.

Largemouth Bass:
14 inch minimum length limit.

Smallmouth Bass: 2 per day, 17-22 inch Protected Length Range (PLR).
Only one fish may be over 22 inches.

Spotted Bass: no creel or length limit.

Crappie (all species): 15 per day in combination, 10 inch minimum length limit.

Catfish (all species): No harvest limit for catfish under 34 inches in length, only one catfish over 34 inches in length may be harvested per day.

Striped Bass:
April - October: 2 per day, 15 inch minimum length limit.

White Bass: 15 per day, no length limit.

Walleye: 5 per day, 16 inch minimum length limit.

Sauger: 10 per day in combination, 15 inch minimum length limit.

Rock Bass: 20 per day, no length limit.

Redear Sunfish: 20 per day, no length limit.

Muskellunge: 1 per day, 36 inch minimum length limit.

Bluegill, Warmouth and other sunfishes:
30 per day, no length limit.

Fishing Tips

Spotted bass: Small white spinners, plastic grubs on leadhead jigs, doll flies, and crawfish crankbaits are all excellent.

Largemouth bass: Use crankbaits, top water lures, Flukes, Bass Assassins, spinners, and Carolina-rigged lizards during April, May, and early June.

Smallmouth bass: Good lures for Norris smallmouth are Silver Buddies, 1/4 oz (or smaller) doll flies, doll flies tipped with minnows, float-and-fly rigs, and large shiners. On windy days in late winter, cast small crankbaits to wind-swept, rocky banks. In early spring smallmouth spawn on gravel points which reach out into the main channels. Spinners or pig'n jigs fished at night on steep, boulder-strewn banks catch good smallmouth year-round.

Crappie: Quality angling is best in the back of major embankments such as Big Sycamore Creek, Davis Creek and Big Creek. Upper river sections above Point 15 (Powell) and Point 31 (Clinch) are also good. Fish close to the brush piles or downed trees in the winter, early spring or late fall months. Small minnows, plastic grubs, flies tipped with minnows, and small crankbaits work best.

Walleye: During river runs, troll or jig with minnow-tipped doll flies, Sparkle Tails, Shiners, Rapalas, or Shad Raps.

In late spring, night anglers cast crankbaits into flooded weeds. Trolling with Jet Lures tipped with night crawlers, spinner-and-night crawler rigs, or with deep running Long-Billed Rebels and Model 911 RedFins is popular by the end of May on the lower end. Night fishing with jiggging spoons, alewife or shad accounts for good catches in the summer.

Norris Lake Fish Habitat Enhancement

The TWRA and volunteers from the public sector, have worked to improve fish habitat in Norris Lake for many years. More than 21,000 structures have been placed in the lake since 1992. A wide variety of fish attractors have been used in an attempt to concentrate fish for anglers. These include brush piles which are used by many game fish, and stake beds which are primarily for concentrating crappie.

These attractors work well, but must continually be refurbished. Bald cypress and black willow trees have been planted in drawdown areas to create additional, long-lasting habitat. Shoreline seeding of grasses during the winter drawdown has the potential of creating spawning habitat and cover for young fish. Inconsistent water levels, however, have rendered any shoreline seeding projects impractical. Spawning benches have been constructed to provide habitat for smallmouth bass reproduction.

Powell River Area



Powell River, Cedar Creek and Davis Creek

The Powell River is one of the two rivers that makes up Norris Lake. It meets the Clinch River about 10 miles northeast of the dam around Anderson County Park at day marker 9. It extends 56 miles northeastward past day marker 18, eventually flowing under 25E just south of Cumberland Gap. The Powell River offers beautiful scenic views of the Cumberland Mountains to the northwest and the Chuck Swan Wildlife Management Area to the south.

The full-service marinas on the Powell River offer a wide variety of comfortable accommodations, boat rentals, food and entertainment. Discover secluded coves, the popular jumping bridge and many beautiful lakefront homes along the shoreline.

Shanghai Resort is located at day marker 10, not far from where Cedar Creek meets the Powell River. Between day markers 10 and 11 is Deerfield Resort, Deerfield Cove Marina and the Tiki Club. Just around the next point is Springs Dock Resort. Flat Hollow Marina Resort and Blue Springs Dock are both a little further down on the Powell River around day marker 14. Union County Marina and a car ferry is located around day marker 15. The Powell River continues over 25 more miles through a lot of calm quiet water.

There are two major creeks that feed into the Powell River, Cedar Creek and Davis Creek. Sugar Hollow Marina is the only dock on Cedar Creek and is close to the Cedar Creek Bridge, also known as the jumping bridge. Davis Creek enters the Powell River around day marker 12 behind an island where it is easy to miss. Powell Valley Resort is located on Davis Creek at day marker 13 at Doakes Creek. Don't miss the awesome view of the Cumberland Mountains from Davis Creek.

There are many secluded coves in the Chuck Swan Wildlife Management Area that borders a lot of the Powell River. For an exciting day, hike into the Chuck Swan Wildlife Management Area and discover the lookout tower or Panther Cave.

The Powell River has a lot of wildlife if you keep your eyes open. Along the shores, watch out for deer, great blue heron, bald eagles and turkeys. You may catch an eagle swooping down to catch a fish, a few deer swimming across the lake or the fish jumping which is a lot more common to see than you think.

Watersports on Norris Lake

Norris Lake has become a favorite haven among waterskiers, wakeboarders, wakesurfers, kneeboarders and jet skiers. Thanks to an abundance of coves and corners to break the wind, the lake provides mile after mile of smooth water. Some of the best ski water anywhere, referred to as glass, can be found on the lake along with a ski course for those looking for a challenge.



If you or your kids like to be pulled behind a boat, on a tube, or other inflatable, you can always find an open part of the lake to have fun. Most of the marinas rent ski boats, pontoon boats, personal water crafts, skis, wakeboards, SUPs and towable tubes for that great day on the lake.

The last couple years, there have been more and more people on stand up paddleboards (SUPs), the newest trend in watersports. It's great exercise, easy to do and fun for all ages, so try it out.

Boating Safety

As a boat owner or operator, YOU are responsible for your safety, the safety of your passengers, and the safety of other boaters. Always be aware and alert when driving.

- Never give your boat or PWC to an inexperienced operator – be responsible.
- Know and obey the laws of the state and the rules of the lake. Visit www.state.tn.us/twra for complete boating laws and information.
- Anyone born after 1-1-89 who operates a boat or PWC, without an adult aboard that was born on or before 1-1-89, must have taken and passed a Coast Guard approved boating education course and have their certificate with them.
- Distribute your load evenly and never overload your boat.
- Provide everyone with an appropriate size PFD before leaving the dock and have them readily available.
- Children 12 and under must wear a Personal Flotation Device while underway. Be sure children's PFDs fit properly.
- Never follow directly behind other boats or PWCs. (Boats do not have brake lights)
- Always be aware of other boats around you. Always look in all directions before starting out, turning or changing course.
- Slow down before approaching docks, boats, swimmers, shore, bridges, busy areas or any object. Always maintain a safe speed depending on your surroundings.
- PWCs cannot be operated between sunset and sunrise.
- No Wake means Idle Speed - you are responsible for all damages from your wake.

The U. S. Coast Guard asks all boat owners and operators to help reduce fatalities, injuries, property damage, and associated healthcare costs related to recreational boating accidents by taking personal responsibility for their own safety and the safety of their passengers. Essential steps include always wearing a life jacket; never boat under the influence; successfully complete a boating safety course; and get a vessel safety check annually from your local U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary or United States Power Squadrons.

Clinch River East Area



Clinch River from Loyston Point to Rt 25E, Mill Creek, Lost Creek, Poor Land Creek, and Big Sycamore Creek

The Clinch River East Area consists of the Clinch River starting just past Stardust Marina around day marker 9 and continues past Loyston Point at day marker 19 where the lake opens up to the widest part. On the big open lake up Mill Creek, you will find Waterside Marina to the southwest around day marker 20. Along the northwestern shore, the Chuck Swan Wildlife Management Area borders the lake. In this part of the lake, there are over a dozen islands to be found. Be careful. There are also a lot of shallow areas, especially up Lost Creek past Sunset Bay around day marker 23.

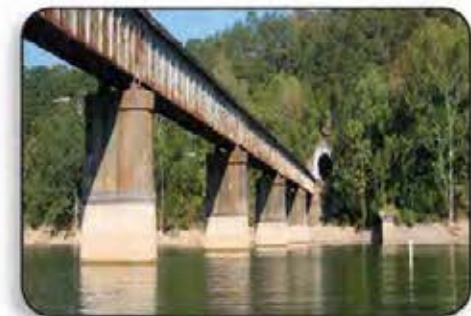
Big Ridge State Park is almost completely surrounded by Norris Lake between day markers 21 and 22 with many secluded and protective coves. The Big Ridge Parks has a swim area and a lake that flows into Norris Lake.

Going up the Clinch River, just past the big open lake, through a small passage and close to even more islands, Hickory Star Marina sits on the southern shore. Lakeview Marina and Beach Island Marina are further up a few miles around day marker 27 and by the 33 bridge. Watch the channel through these areas to keep safe.

Stop in at Bubba Brew Sports Bar and Grill at Beach Island Marina to catch a game on TV, to play a game of corn hole or for good food and drinks. Bubba's is one of a few places on the lake that serves liquor.

Past the 33 bridge is Cedar Grove Marina by day marker 28. Straight Creek Dock is just around the corner before you get to the Lone Mountain Shores development. The New Norris Landing Marina is at day marker 30 and Lone Mountain Boat Dock is just a little further, back by Big Sycamore Creek. Woodlake lodge, golf and country club is close to Lone Mountain Dock around Big Sycamore Creek.

Norris Lake continues to wind back and forth up the Clinch River for over 15 more undisturbed miles until it flows under 25E, where it becomes too shallow to navigate. On the shores you can see deer, cows and horses, some wading in the lake.

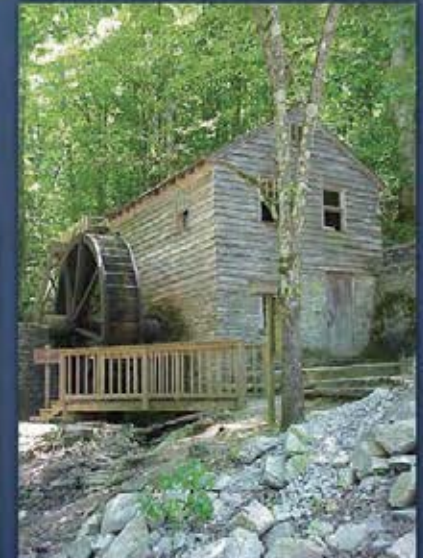

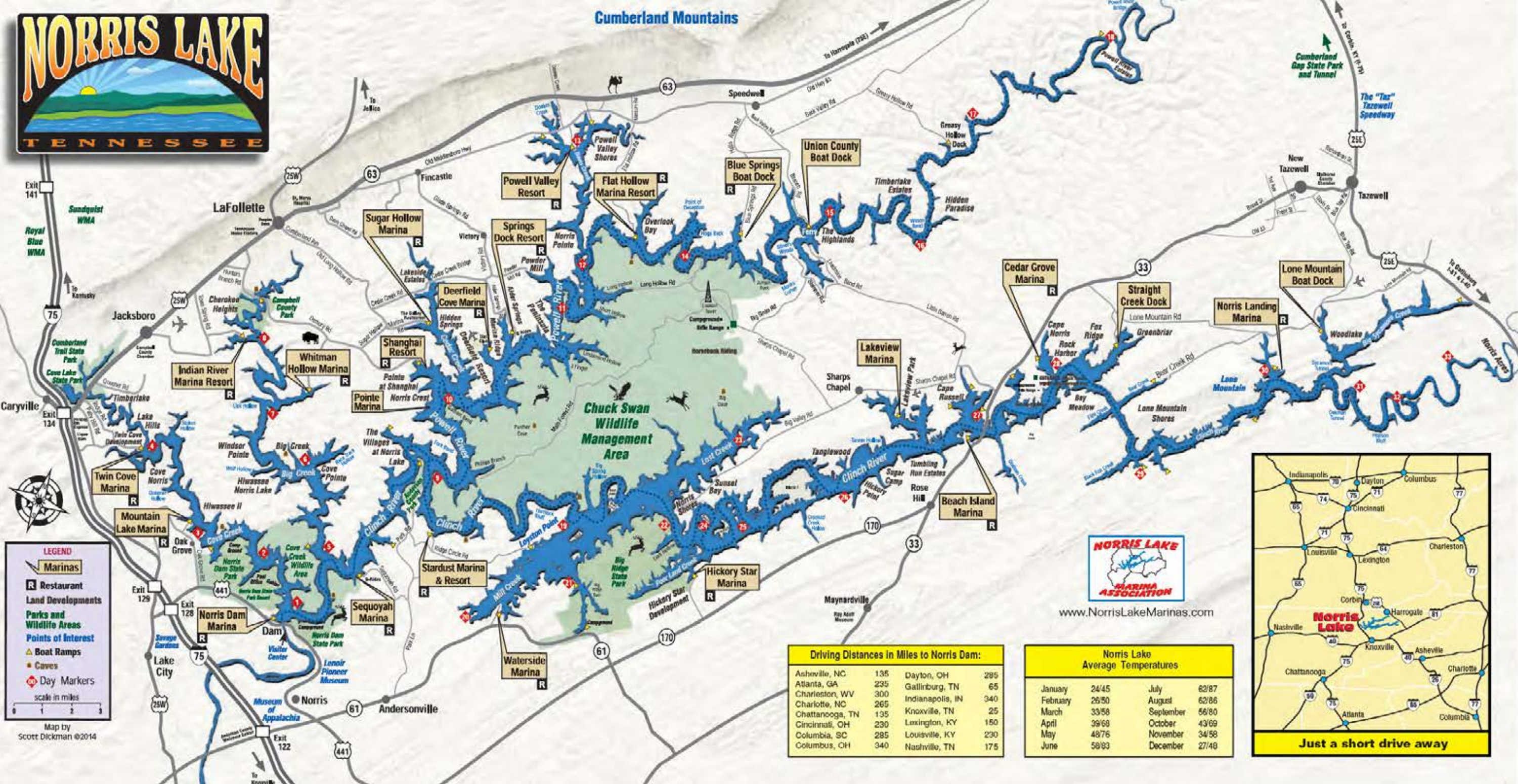
